She is responsible for all exhibitor services from freight through personnel. She will be your primary contact for exhibitor information. We're delighted at the opportunity to work with you to make this show a success for all.

Our programming committee has begun identifying what is fresh and new in our industry and is open to ideas of ways we might diversify the content. We will continue to focus on corrugated, folding carton, foil and engraving while looking for new, cutting edge, educational opportunities in plastics, foams, gaskets and perhaps something we do not even know about yet. Many of our educational programs will again take place in the Techshop.[™] The Techshop offers attendees a one-of-akind experience with live, operating equipment available





for informative and educational programs and hands-on teaching. We've already received a number of inquiries from companies who wish to place equipment in the Techshop; this is always one of the big draws for Odyssey.

BONUS OPPORTUNITY - TECHSHOP™ SPACE

In addition to the equipment used during the educational sessions, this year's TechshopTM will feature ample space for more exhibitors to showcase their equipment. Our goal is to create an exciting and fully functional die shop, and the Odyssey Planning Task Force reserves the right to approve selections to provide as wide a diversity of equipment as possible. Due to the exceptional opportunity for selected companies, the costs of drayage, installation, waste disposal, electrical, air and other operating and maintenance expenses incurred during the show are the responsibility of the participating companies. Techshop space is available in $10' \times 10'$ blocks, at the same rate as booth space. Exhibitors must also contract for a minimum of one exhibit booth to be eligible for Techshop space. To take advantage of this opportunity, contact Sue Corcoran.

WILL YOU HAVE MACHINERY IN THE TECHSHOP™ OR IN YOUR BOOTH?

Even with our ample space, we can see already that the **Techshop is going to be chock full of machinery!** If you're considering bringing equipment for the Techshop, please let Sue know asap so that we can include you in the floor plan.

If you're more inclined to place your machinery in your booth(s), it would still be a great idea to let Sue know this information as soon as possible. We may choose to give you extra exposure in our promotional materials and on the website.

DO YOU REQUIRE 480V OR 208V POWER?

If you plan to showcase equipment or machinery that uses 480V or 208V power, please let Sue know as soon as possible. Note that such equipment or machinery MUST be placed within the green areas on the Technology Hall layout in order to access the special power bus ducts. You will want to keep this in mind when planning your booth space.

KEEPING THE COSTS DOWN

We understand that it is important for us to help you contain costs. We are pleased to note that exhibit space at the Odyssey again costs less than other comparable industry shows, while providing a directly targeted audience and measurable return on investment. Room rates at our head-quarters hotels, the Hyatt Regency Milwaukee and the Hilton Milwaukee City Center, are attractively priced at \$165 US and \$159 US, respectively. Most importantly, we've connected again with Shepard Exposition Services, our previous event services provider and partner for six expos, and

we've secured competitive material handling, labor and machine handling rates.

MAKE YOUR HOTEL RESERVATIONS NOW

We strongly urge you to **make your reservations now** if you are planning to stay at one of the two headquarters hotels!

Elevate your stay at **Hyatt Regency Milwaukee**. This downtown hotel next to the Wisconsin Center convention facility offers pet-friendly rooms and suites, market-to-table dining and an onsite Starbucks®. Experience the best of Milwaukee with easy access to nearby attractions. Parking is \$18 per day for parking at the 310 W structure (747 N Old World 3rd St.). Valet parking is available for \$31 per day. Our special room rate is \$165US single/double (plus applicable state and local taxes). Hilton Milwaukee City Center is an Art Deco landmark hotel in downtown Milwaukee, built in 1927. It retains many of its original features and is connected by skywalk to the Wisconsin Center convention facility. It's located within a mile of the Pabst Theater, Milwaukee Art Museum, Fiserv Forum, and Deer District. Enjoy four dining options including the Miller Time Pub. Our special room rate is \$159US single/double (plus applicable state and local taxes). Be sure to note both hotels' deposit and cancellation policies: A credit card is required to guarantee all guest room reservations. All arriving guests must present a valid credit card upon check in. Room, taxes and fees will be authorized against the card. On Wednesday, April 5, 2023 all reservations for which a deposit has not already been collected will be charged a non-refundable deposit of two nights' room and tax. For any reservation canceled after 11:59pm central time on Tuesday, April 4, 2023, the deposit will be forfeited and not returned. All reservations are subject to an early departure fee of one night's room and tax if a guest checks out prior to the confirmed checkout date. Other cancellation policies are located on the hotels' websites.
